Reminder from the City of Bonham: Disinfectant wipes, toiletries will stress sewer lines and the sewer treatment plant.

The City of Bonham wants to remind residents that during the heightened usage of disinfectant and hygiene wipes, the City's sewer lines, and treatment plant can only handle so much. As the chief operator of the City of Bonham Waste Treatment Plant along with the City's public works department, we want to address the disposal of many of these types of wipes before it becomes an issue.

The following items are often found to be the cause of stoppages in the City sewer lines and treatment plant and should NEVER be disposed of by flushing into the Sanitary Sewer Collection system:

- Disinfectant, antibacterial, and personal hygiene wipes
- Grease
- Food Scraps
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Disposable diapers
- Cigarette Butts (from ashtrays emptied into toilets and flushed)
- Shop rags
- Plastic bags
- Mop heads
- Disposable mopping cloths
- Facial tissues (Kleenex, etc.)
- Condiment packets
- Condoms
