



The CITY OF BONHAM water system PWS ID 0740001 has violated the monitoring/ reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administration Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of the monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of 01/01/2018-03/31/2018.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The City of Bonham has reported the 1st Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operation report to TCEQ as of 07/03/2018. During the 1st Quarter the City of Bonham's distribution system was properly disinfected and maintained acceptable disinfection residuals and was recorded daily. Future Reports will be timely.
